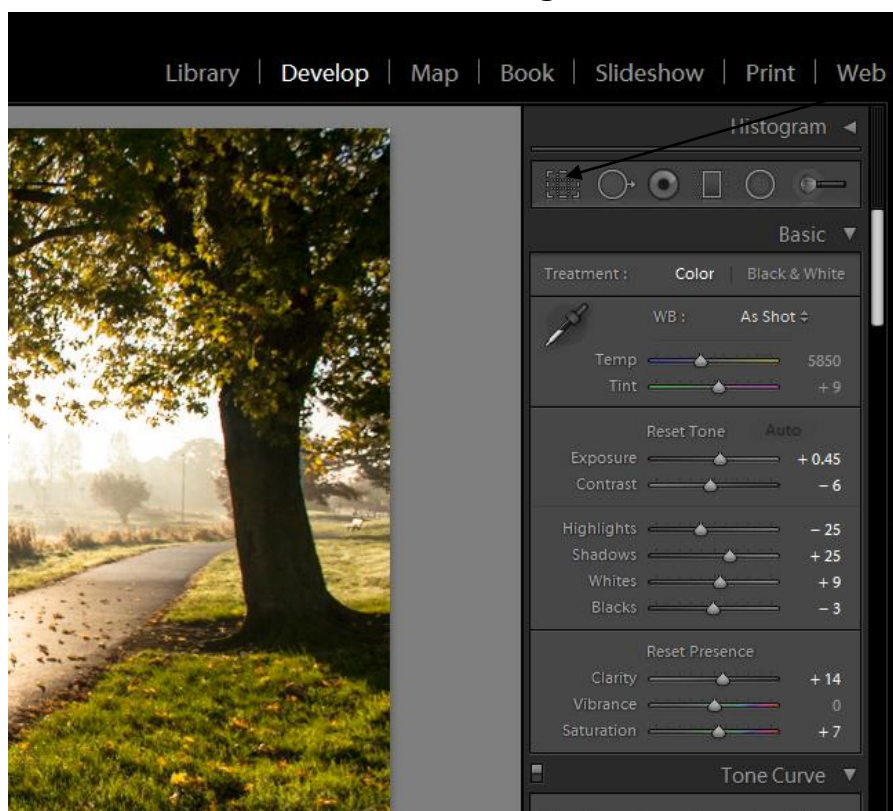

The basic aspects looked for in a photograph is composition, exposure and sharpness. The workshop will take you through how to adjust these with Adobe Lightroom®. All the options we use in Lightroom® this evening are in the 'Develop' module.

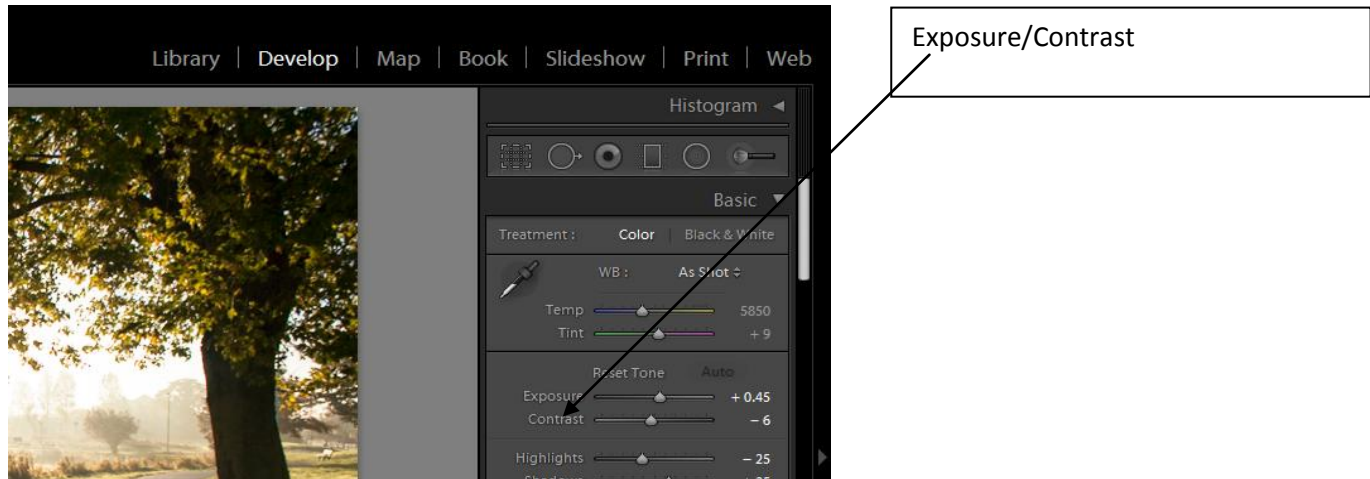
Composition

There are a lot of recommendations on how to compose a photograph when taking it. Sometimes either for location reasons or lens reasons you cannot get the exact composition you want. This is addressed in any editing tool by cropping the photograph. Diagram below shows where this is in Lightroom.



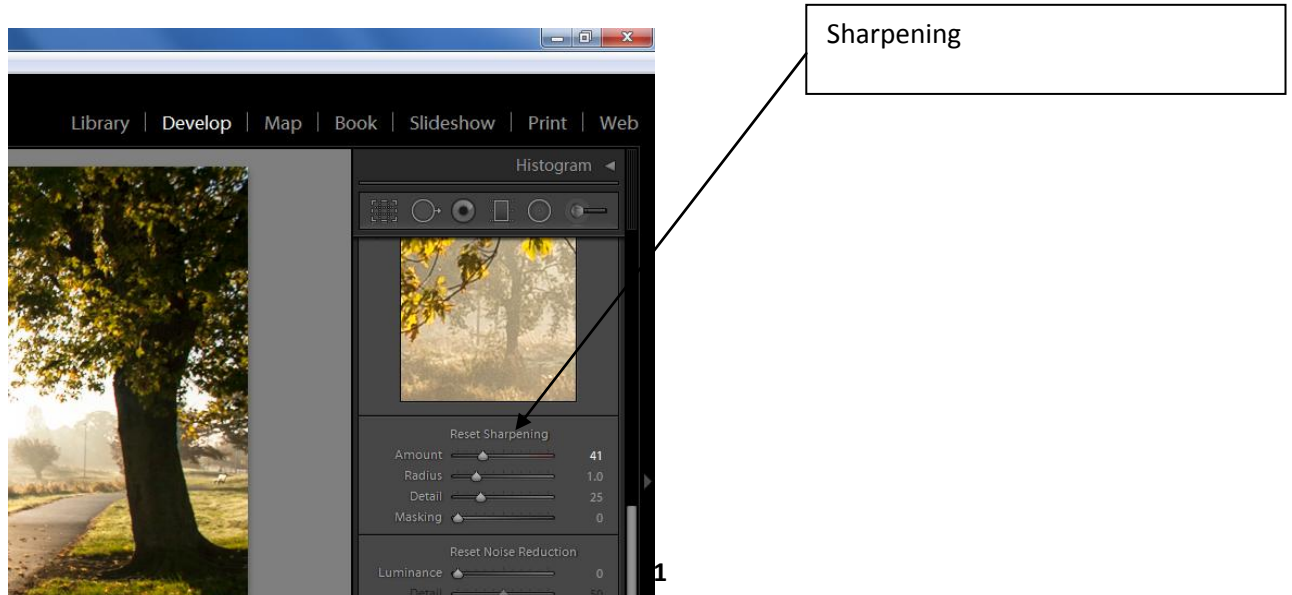
Exposure

Exposure is about having the correct level of light in the photograph and there are technical definitions around this. For simplicity today we are looking at exposure and contrast. Diagram below shows where this is.



Sharpness

Sharpness should be caught at time of the photograph with correct focus but that does not always happen. Option is down the menu so you need to scroll down.
